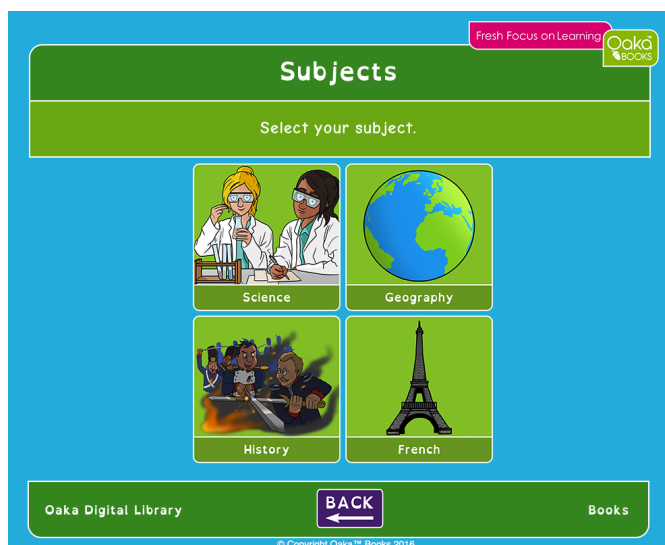


These instructions will enable you to:

- login to your home educator account.
- create student accounts.
- access quizzes.
- use your home educator account.
- check student results.

- view the Question Bank.
- technical information.

Once signed up for a year's subscription or the 30 day free trial, you will be asked what you would like your domain name to be. This domain name will be how you access Oaka™ Digital.

## THE DIGITAL LIBRARY OVERVIEW



Within the digital library, each subject is split into separate topics. In these topics, there is a Topic Book (a PDF version of our printed books), access to Oaka's quiz system and access to additional resources.

The topic books, the quiz library and certain resources open in a new tab. To return to the digital library, simply close these tabs.

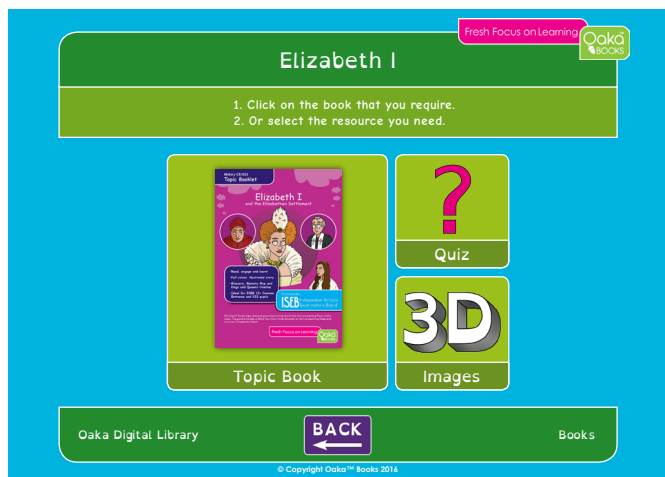
### To get started:

The Oaka™ Team will contact you for a list of home educators so we can create accounts for them.

Students can then sign up and create their own accounts.

Home Educator accounts provide the ability to manage students accounts, view the complete question list, access all quizzes and view student results.




## LOGIN TO YOUR HOME EDUCATOR ACCOUNT

Once you have signed up for Oaka™ Digital, the Oaka™ team will set up your home educators digital library. You will be contacted directly by the team for a list of home educators who will require accounts on the system for access. Once completed, the Oaka™ Team will send you all the account details.

## STUDENT ACCOUNTS

Students can create their own accounts in order to gain access to the quiz by following the steps below:

- They will need to head to:

- From the login screen, they click on “Register a new account” on the bottom left corner (shown by the orange arrow).
- Then they fill in their contact details (seen below). If you do not require a contact number for your students, this can be left blank.
- If your students do not have email addresses, they can set up their accounts by using the format “firstname@surname”. You can use any format you prefer as long as the email field includes the @ sign.



# ACCESS QUIZZES (STUDENTS AND HOME EDUCATORS)

To gain access to the quiz, head to:

Although the home educators and student accounts are different, all quizzes can be accessed by clicking “Quiz” and then “Quiz List” in the top tool-bar here it redirects you to the quiz list page. As a student, the quiz list will be loaded automatically as the first page you see.

Once you login as a home educator, you will be directed to the dashboard page. From here, you can see:

- All of your students signed up to your account through the “Users List” OR by clicking the “Users” link in the top tool-bar (shown by the yellow arrow).
- The question list through “Question List” OR by clicking “Question Bank” in the top tool-bar (shown by the orange arrow).
- The quiz list through “Quiz List” OR by clicking the “Quiz” link in the top tool-bar (shown by the red arrow).

# CHECK STUDENT RESULTS

When logged into your home educator's account, click "Results" in the top tool-bar. From here, you will be able to see all of your students' results.

Searching by student name, subject or individual quiz requires you to type it into the search bar in order to gain a results list (shown by the yellow arrow). For example, typing in "Geography" will give you all of the Geography quizzes.

By clicking "view" (shown by the orange arrow), you can get an in-depth analysis of that student's results. Overviews of your student's results can be seen at the top in a box (shown to the right).

As a home educator, you will also be able to see the top 10 across all students for that particular quiz. By scrolling down, you can then see which questions the student has got correct, incorrect or didn't answer.



## GENERATE REPORTS

The generate report feature on the Results page allows you to create a report of results which will download onto your computer as a comma separated text file. This can be opened in Excel or other spreadsheet software. These results can be based on class, quiz or group.


To generate, select the quiz/class/group, enter the date range that you wish for the report to include and then click "Generate Report".



## THE QUESTION BANK

As a home educator, you will be able to view all questions individually. To access this, click "Question Bank" in the tool-bar (shown by the yellow arrow) and then click "Question List".

Questions can be searched either by the subjects or topics drop down menu and then click "Filter" (shown by the orange arrow). Alternatively, you can type in the search bar.

## 8. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

As you will notice, the domain name that you use to access the digital library is specific to what you have chosen. Each home educator's library and database is held individually to ensure maximum security of your information and to ensure that we can easily monitor access and usage. The library is hosted on a dedicated Linux virtual server which is running Apache web services and MySQL database server.

Due to the file sizes, we host all of our books in an Amazon Web Service S3 secure bucket. All of this comes together to ensure that children aren't left waiting for things to load, whilst also ensuring that all database data is held securely with absolutely no crossover.
